

BOARD MEMBERS RESIGNATIONS AND REMOVAL FROM OFFICE

A Board member who resigns shall file his resignation with the Superintendent of Schools, who shall file same with the District Clerk. A Board member or Officer may be removed from office by the Commissioner of Education under specific conditions as stated in the Education Law.

A Board member may be removed from office for non-attendance by the Board of Education. However, before a trustee can be declared to have vacated his/her office, the record must be clear that he/she deliberately failed to attend four meetings and has no sufficient excuse therefore. If a trustee has sufficient reason to warrant absence from the meetings, a vacancy cannot be declared.
